

mema

mema is a new, powerful, fast, and destructive mail-bomber built for Mac OS X and being coded by DCHKG (active member of the Underground Mac Programming Team). Unlike other mail-bombers (like Team2600's Bomba), it waits for the remote smtp server's answers before sending any mail commands. With **mema**, you are able to mail-bomb multiple email addresses and connect to multiple SMTP servers simultaneously. **mema** opens up to 500 connections at the same time, and detects any time-out errors or misconnections in order to immediately reconnect the matching socket.

More information about some of **mema**'s various functions :

- anonymous mode : this allows you to be as anonymous as possible but please note unfortunately your IP address will be visible in the email source anyway.
- send amounts of special characters : this makes the sent emails contain a lot of special characters (those which have a high ASCII code). In addition to being really annoying, large amounts of those characters make Mail (the email client from Apple) crash ;).
- time-out : Sets the time (in seconds) to wait for an SMTP server's response before automatically reconnecting.
- never ending mail-bombing : the mail-bombing process keeps going until the stop button is pressed.
- clone RCPT : this option is hidden into the "mode" / "recipient's parameters" menu. (Aren't you glad you read the Read Me file ? ;). It lets you clone the first recipient's email address 25, 50 or 100 times as if you wanted to send the same email to multiple email addresses. This makes the mail-bombing process even faster!
- connection benchmark : this process creates 500 sockets and tries to connect them randomly to one of your smtp servers. It detects how many of them have been actually connected and gives you the maximum power of your connection. This process may disconnect you so **mema** always reconnects you at the end of the benchmark.

VERSION HISTORY

- Version 4.0 : new sheet windows, "reconnect if disconnected" function fixed.
- Version 3.7 : better presentation of encountered mailing errors, at the end of the bombing process. I noted that when sending only one message encountered mailing errors presentation were skipped, the application just said message was sent although it was not. I fixed it.
- Version 3.5 : new iTunes like list boxes. Accents ("é", "è", "à", etc.) and atypical characters are now supported! A bug that could trigger a OutOfBoundsException error on process initiation has been fixed.
- Version 3.2 : the presentation screen only prompts at first launch, so if you want to see it more than once you have to delete the mema's preferences file, you are now able to set the date (thus that bug was fixed), the message encoding system has been fixed, application's default language has been set to English.
- Version 3.1 : some minor interface changes, checkboxes added to the "smtp servers" list box in order to allow you to choose which smtp server(s) you want to use for an attack, drag and drop abilities added (concerns "recipient's email(s)", "subject", "message" and "smtp servers"), improved graphical interface under Mac OS X 10.3.
- Version 3.0 : **mema** sockets' code has been rewritten to fit with new development tools' improvements. The "domain" editfield and the "use helo command" checkbox have been removed

because they're now obsolete. I think it's really great you don't have to bother this settings anymore. Maybe I'll receive less emails pretending **mema** doesn't work, what is great too ;-). The mail-bombing process should run faster. One problem : you're no longer able to set the date... It's a problem that comes from the new development tools. The victim(s) will always receive the current date when you send the email(s). Maybe this will be fixed in **mema**'s next version.

- Version 2.6 : File attachment support is better. A mail-bombing progress window has been added to check sockets' status during the mail-bombing process. Some little problem with the time-out managing has been fixed to make **mema** run faster. While debugging, the **mema** sound when the application opens began to come on my nerves. I found it irritating so I removed it.

- Version 2.5 : some bugs with the emails headers treatment have been fixed. The mailing process code has been cleaned and improved. File attachment is possible but the process is not adapted to files that size more that 100 Kb. That's why this version of **mema** was not released.

- Version 2.1 : some bugs have been corrected.

- Version 1.6 : a debug screen has been removed ;). Connection benchmark can be deactivated, smtp server testing system has been improved.

- Version 1.5 : name changed to **mema** and new features : more simultaneous connections (up to 500 !!!), connection benchmark test to check your connection power, time-out process accelerated, smtp test process partially recoded, reconnection process improved, some little bugs corrected.

- Version 1.0 : initial release of "iMail".
